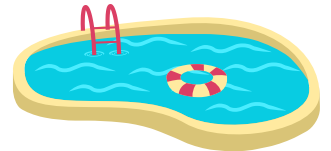

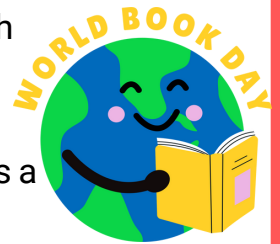

We will be celebrating World Book Day in school on Thursday 6th March. Please put this in your diaries. We are hoping to run our annual book swap and include some dressing up fun. - Class 4 – Jasper’s Beanstalk by Nick Butterworth
Children can come dressed as gardeners, animals from the garden, or even a beanstalk itself! They could also choose another Mick Inkpen story or character.
- Class 3 – Where the Wild Things Are by Maurice Sendak
Suggested costumes include party monsters, Max in his crown and white suit, or any of the Wild Things from the story.
