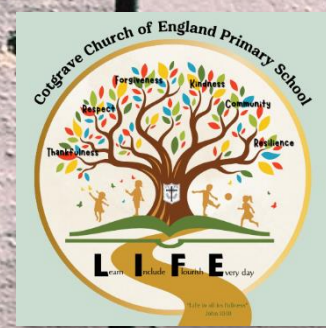


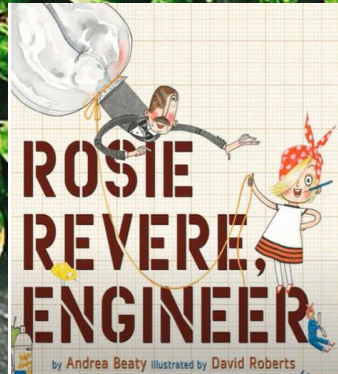
# Spring 2 - Class 3
