

Uniform Expectations

As the weather is turning warmer, just a reminder on uniform expectation.

- On non-PE days, children can wear grey skirts, red summer dresses or grey school shorts. Black cycling type shorts or leggings should **not** be worn.
- Polo shirts on non-PE days should be white. These can have a logo or not.
- Red school PE tops should be worn on PE days. These can be worn with black shorts (cycling type is fine for PE), leggings or joggers. Please ensure that these are plain and do not have stripes or large logos on them.
- Trainers should **only** be worn on PE days and should be black. If you are unable
 to find black trainers then please make sure that the trainers are mostly black.
 Small emblems in a different colour on trainers is acceptable.
