This will involve the children in Class 4 (Nursery and Reception) only.

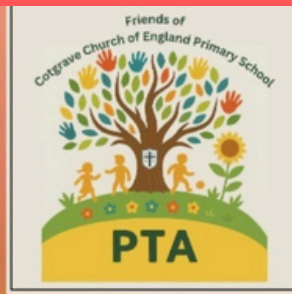
Monday 15th December 10:30 am at Church- Pushchair Nativity.
