Remembrance

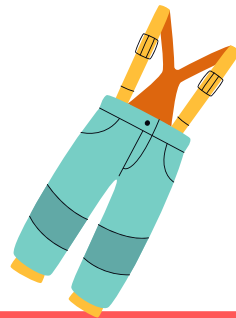
To mark Remembrance day on Monday 11th November, we will be selling poppies and other poppy-related items on behalf of the British Legion who provide support to the armed forces community.
